How To Start Scratch Building With Styrene.

To create highly detailed buildings one has to make a model of a facade. Using the right styrene the facade is plastic and can be shaped in many ways.

EASY AS 1, 2, 3

RESEARCH YOUR SUBJECT

I have found that research for historical buildings requires more time than actual construction.

Step 1

MAKE THE MASTER MOLD

To create a building with details you have to build a one dimensional facing. This is glued to a panel and framed. Then the front facing is lubricated. Silicone rubber is poured over all and left to harden.

Step 2

THE FINAL PIECE

The hardened silicone is peeled from the object. Then the mold is placed in a vacuum machine and a sheet of plastic is placed over the mold. The heat from the vacuum machine pulls the styrene to the shape of the object.
